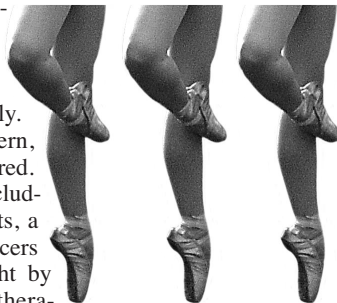

Tyler Civic Ballet's Summer Intensive Workshop is designed for the serious dance student, intermediate through advanced, and offers a renowned faculty to encourage each student to perform at their highest level. Classes in classical ballet technique with pointe classes including variations from the classical repertory will be held daily. Classes in jazz, modern, and lyrical are also offered. Educational classes including healthy eating habits, a dancers body, the dancers foot, etc. will be taught by physicians, physical therapists and dieticians from Trinity Mother Frances Hospital. Dancers must be 9 yrs. of age with one year of previous training. Auditions are not required.

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Kym Lanier received her training with Donna Pope in Picayune, Mississippi. She attended the University of Southern Mississippi where she continued her dance training while also majoring in Exercise Physiology. She then moved to Jackson, MS where she opened Studio One Academy of Performing Arts. Mrs. Lanier served as the performing company's Artistic Director and while under her direction, the company received numerous local, regional, and national awards. Her students have received many individual awards and scholarships and her choreography still takes top honors at regional and national competitions. Mrs. Lanier has been with TCB for two years where she has directed "Snow White" and "Cinderella". She continues to guest teach and choreograph for regional companies throughout the Southeast.

GUEST FACULTY

Jennifer Beasley began her training with Linda Ford in Monroe, Louisiana. She trained with the Twin City Ballet in Monroe and at the University of Louisville in Louisville, Kentucky where she pursued a double major in dance and communications. She danced professionally for the Louisville Ballet for two years and for Ballet Mississippi for five years, including the last season of her professional career under dance legend Fernando Bujones. She served as Ballet Mistress for Ballet Mississippi School for the year following her professional career. Currently, Mrs. Beasley owns the MS Metropolitan Dance Academy with locations in Madison and Brandon, MS. She also guest performs, guest teaches, and choreographs for regional companies throughout the United States.

Eric J. Kegler began his dancing career after studying at New York University. While in school he was an award recipient in choreography from the Arts Recognition and Talent Search as well as being a three time Gala Award Recipient at the American College Dance Festival. Eric danced professionally with Cleveland San Jose Ballet and performed both soloists and principal roles with Cincinnati Ballet. He is best known for his World Premiere of the role of Peter Pan in the ballet by the same name. He has recently returned from Vienna, Austria where he performed and choreographed a PBS special at the Hofburg Imperial Palace which aired all over the country.

HOUSING

ATTIRE

Female dancers are required to wear black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers and pointe shoes (if applicable). Male dancers are required to wear black tights, white t-shirt and ballet shoes. Black jazz shoes are required for jazz and jazz pants are optional for both male and female students. Hair must be neatly secured in a bun for all classes.

Students should bring a daily sack lunch and drink. One day we will have lunch provided by a local participating Hearts Delight restaurant.

COMPANY AUDITIONS



Company auditions will be held Friday, June 13 during the first class of the day. You must be 12 years old to audition. As a Company Member you must be enrolled in two weekly ballet classes and one weekly pointe class.
